

# Community Cohesion Baseline Survey Analysis

## Army Welfare Service

### Brief

BE Group was appointed to analyse the results of a questionnaire survey carried out by the Army Welfare Service at Catterick Garrison.

The questionnaire investigated:

- Community awareness of the social, welfare and community services available to them and the extent to which they use them
- Army families' awareness, perceptions, use and understanding of the Army Welfare Service
- The sense of community at Catterick Garrison and how residents feel about where they live and the issues that are important to them
- Resident's engagement with, and understanding of, community regeneration
- The links Catterick Garrison has with its neighbouring communities.



### Activities

- Input of surveys into database
- Analysis of findings
- Discussion of requirements and initial outcomes with client
- Report writing
- Presentation of recommendations.

Our report:

- Provided background on community cohesion, the key indicators for achieving it and the importance of investigating it
- Commented on the population of Catterick Garrison, its characteristics and community life
- Outlined the methodology employed for the survey, a justification of the approach and its limitations
- Presented the results of the survey
- Included a analysis of the results and key findings
- Made recommendations and identified where research was needed.
