The Plan is to provide a coherent framework to implement the Market Town Healthcheck objectives, and secure NWDA funding.

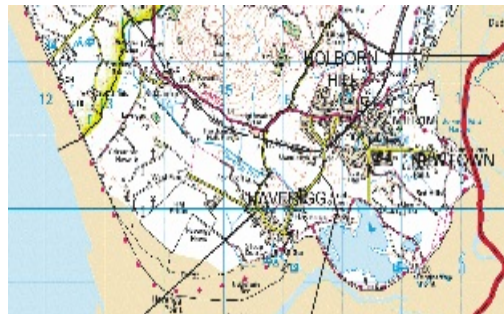
The Plan required the identification of delivery partners, funding mechanisms and phasing of projects under the following themes:

- Employment
- ICT
- Tourism
- Transport
- Community Facilities
- Community Services



Activities

- Review of baseline position for each theme
- Consultation with key stakeholders including employers, partnerships, communities and public sector agencies
- Consultation with young people
- Organised and delivered a workshop to gain support from internal and external stakeholders for projects
- Review of key strategic documents
- Identification and development of key projects
- Development of delivery mechanism.



Outcome

The Operational Plan has provided a co-ordinated regeneration programme for Millom for the next five years. It has developed 25 projects including:

- Training and Enterprise Centre
- The Tannery Regeneration
- Youth Resource Centre
- Employers Forum.

For each project the following were identified:

- Potential partners
- Financial resources
- NWDA's tier 2 and 3 outputs
- Delivery mechanism.
