St Fagans National History Museum just outside Cardiff opened in 1948. It was the first open air museum in the UK. With over 40 original buildings from all over Wales, it is the country's most popular visitor attraction, with over 600,000 visits each year. The redevelopment project is enabling the incorporation of social history and archaeology collections on site and refurbishment and upgrade of the existing facilities.
